It is finally great to get our third season in the league underway after a proudly thrilling but ultimately disappointing summer cheering on those mighty three lions of England.

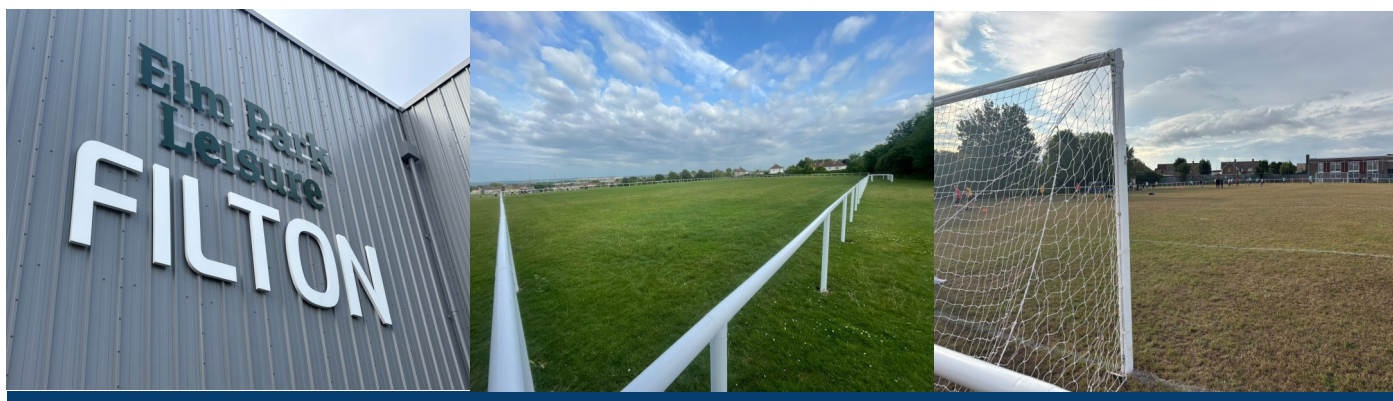

Our First Team competes in the **Gloucestershire County Football League** following a Championship-winning promotion from the **Bristol & Suburban Premier Division** in the 2023/24 season. Our Reserve Team also earned promotion last season and now competes in the **Bristol & Suburban Premier Division**, while our newly formed '**A**' Team begins its inaugural campaign in the **Bristol & Suburban Division Four**.

Following facility improvements during the summer of 2025, all senior teams now proudly call **BBS Park North at Filton Leisure Centre, Elm Park** their home.

The club's commitment to developing local football extends beyond the senior game. In 2023, Filton Athletic FC launched its Youth Section, which has grown to include teams from **Under-7s through to Under-12s**, as well as a **Youth Development Squad (YDS)**, creating a clear pathway for young players to progress within the club.

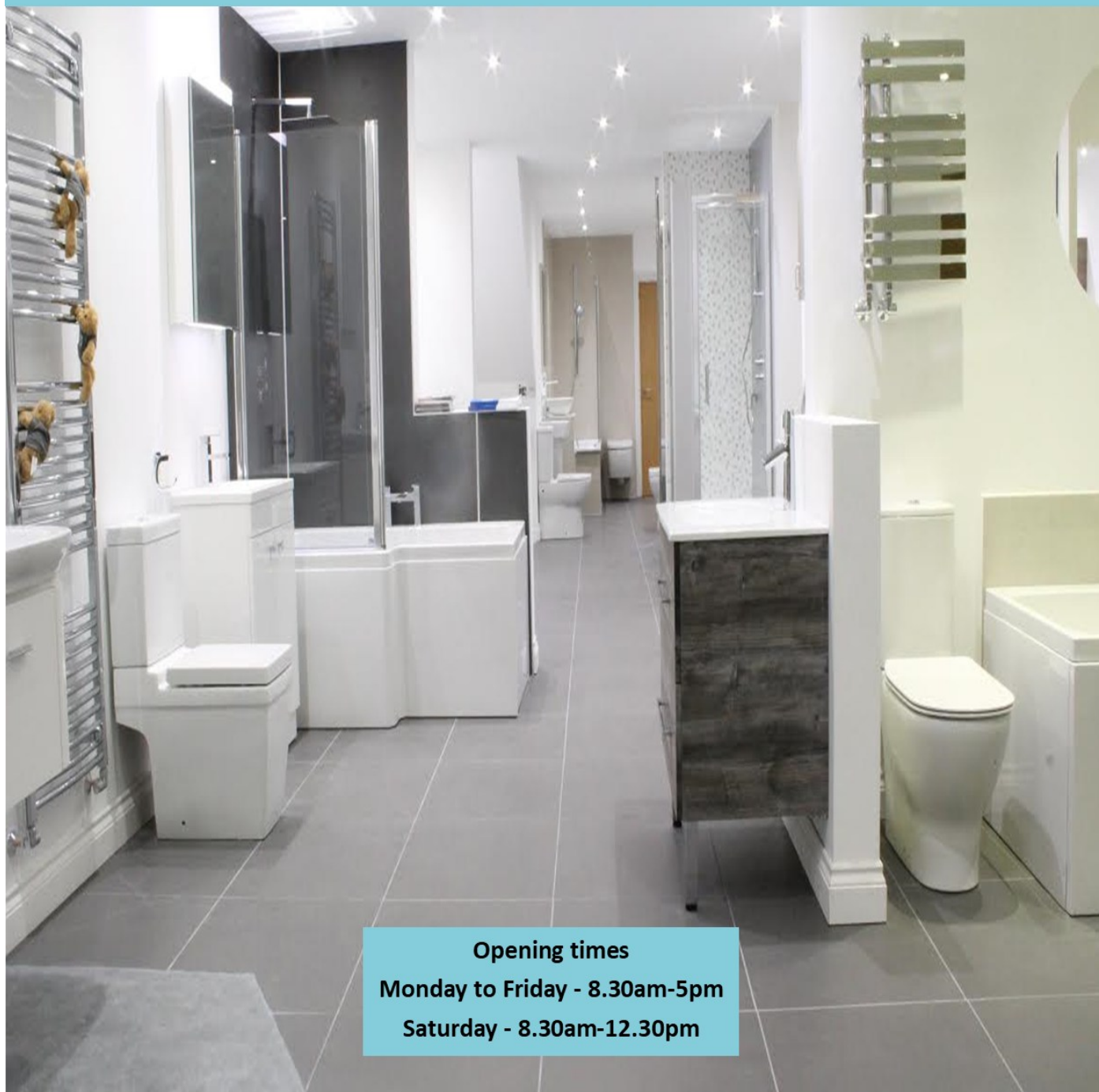


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Meet Our Squad

History

The University of Bristol Athletic Football Club (UBAFC) has played in the British Universities and College Sport (BUCS) competitions since they were formed in 2008.

UBAFC has six teams competing across the BUCS Aldi Men's Western Leagues, from the

sixth tier to the first tier, as well as a Saturday team created in 2023, currently competing in

the Gloucestershire County Football League. UBAFC is one of the largest, most sociable and

most successful clubs at the University of Bristol.

UBAFC has experienced a successful few years, with the First Team winning BUCS Division

1 in 2020, 2025 and secured promotion to the Men's Premier South Division after securing

victory in the promotion playoff against the University of Sussex in 2026. In the Saturday

team's debut season in 2023/24, UBAFC finished runners up in the Hellenic Division Two

West and won the Bateman Sports Chairmans Challenge Cup, beating Letcombe, before

losing the Marsh Supplementary Challenge Cup final to FC Stratford on penalties.

In the 24/25 season, UBAFC finished 3rd in Hellenic Division Two and reached the quarter

finals of the Marsh Challenge Cup, losing narrowly to Hellenic League Premier Division

outfit Fairford Town. UBAFC also retained the Bateman Sports Chairmans Challenge Cup,

beating Swindon Supermarine 5-0 in the final.

The 25/26 season saw UBAFC secure promotion to the Gloucestershire County
