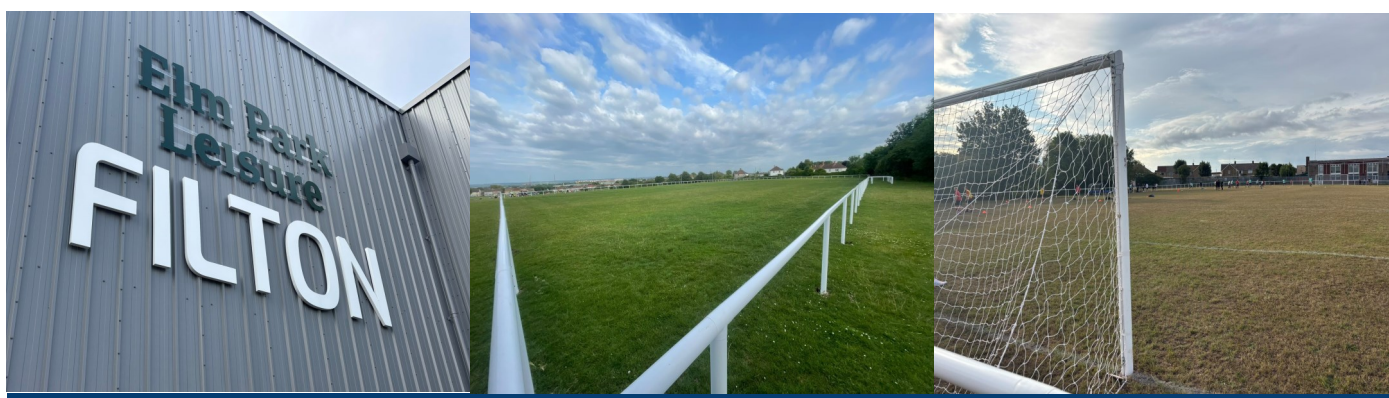

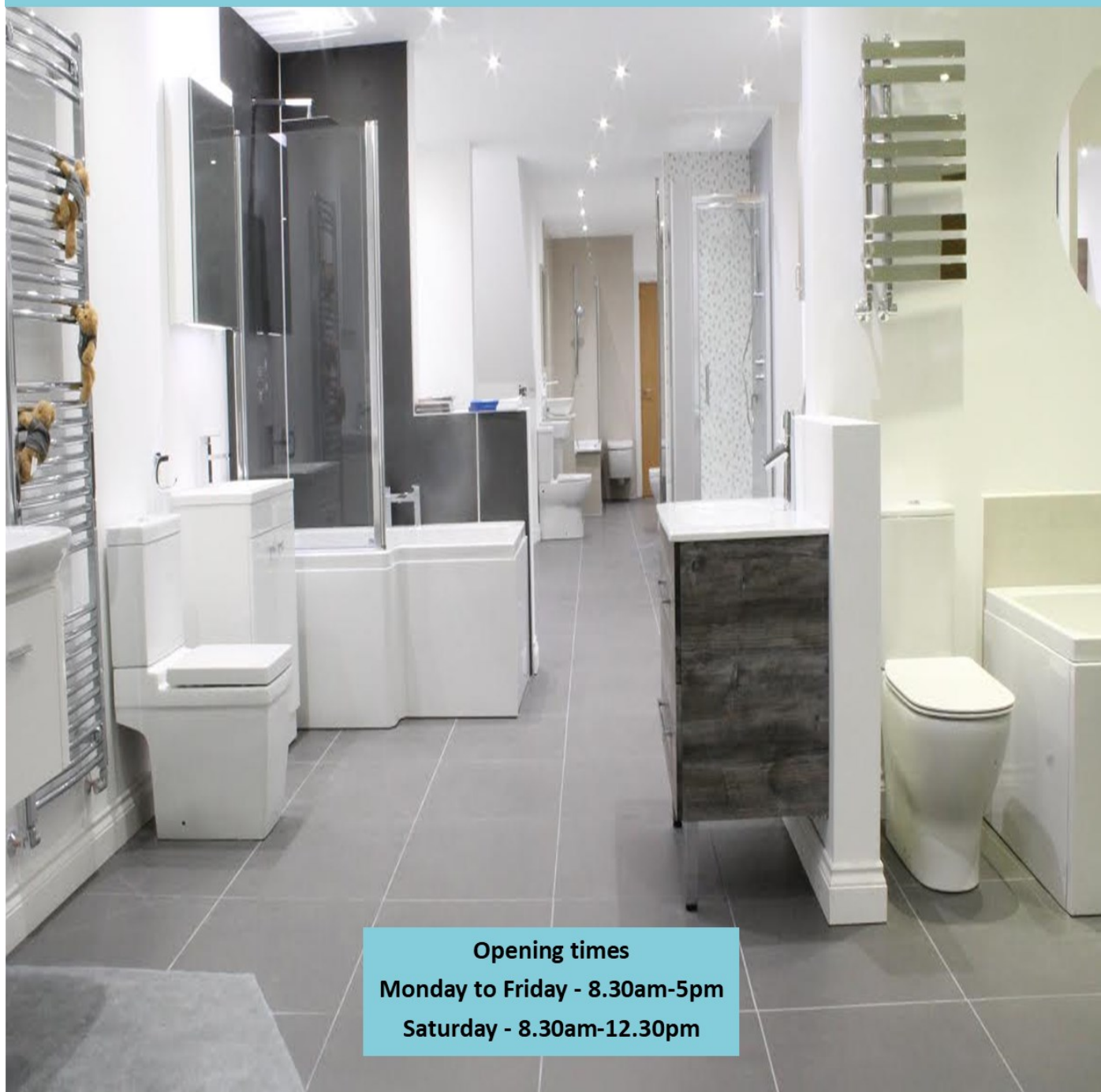

Club History

QWFC was formed in 1994, with just one boy's under 14's team. It was started by Dave Mulrain and Ron Capper, who took on the roles of Secretary and Treasurer, positions they went on to hold for a further ten years. Dave has since returned to the club as Chairman and is in his sixth season. They laid the foundations for the club to grow to the present day where we have over 400 members across 23 competitive teams of all ages, including girls sides, 2 adult teams, walking football and Veterans. Many hours have been dedicated to the club by a number of volunteers to get to the point we are at today. In July 2021, we installed floodlights due to gaining a grant from Crest Nicholson. They were installed by MUSCO lighting who have installed lights in many Premier league sides.

We continue this season with our Seniors Committee, with James Mulrain taking the vice chairman seat. Kelly Mulrain will continue in her role as Seniors Secretary. Dave Mulrain and James Mulrain will work alongside Andy Gutteridge in the Treasurer's role.

Joining Quedgeley this season to take the reins of the first team is Beckem Foley. Beckem joins us from Cheltenham Saracens after successfully running their under 18s side and being part of coaching team for the Hellenic side. He brings knowledge and experience to help build a strong County League side. Tony Hawkins will continue to assist and coach the team. A mixture of old faces and many new faces will combine to make a thriving side in the League.

Our Reserve team are currently in Stroud League Division 3. Ash Pocock will be continuing as Manager, having taken up the role part way through last season. With some new faces, and a mixture of young and mature players, we have high hopes for Ash's full season in charge.

This season we are proudly introducing our first ever under 18s side which will be competing in the Cheltenham Youth Floodlit League floodlit.

We have a brilliant bunch of players/management both on and off the field and wish both teams the best of luck this season.

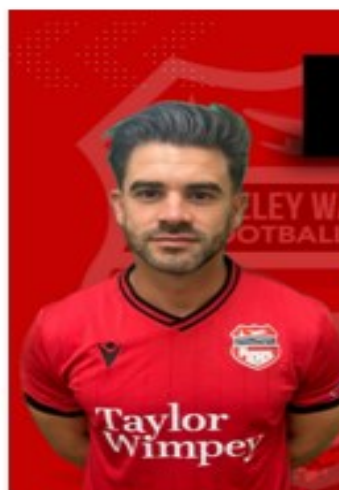

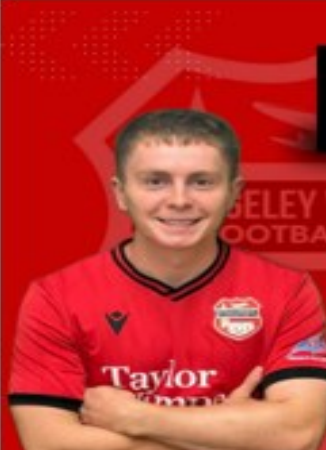
